2. Attend all scheduled meetings.
3. Wear the complete WBPS School Uniform at all times.
4. Wear the badge at all times.
5. Follow the WBPS TRACK agreements.
6. Complete to the best of their ability all of the roles and jobs assigned.

Head Students

Attend the Halogen Foundation National Leader's Day (March), speak at Assemblies, chair regular Student Representative Council (SRC) meetings, prepare and pack away the Duty board and Duty bags each day, organise and host fundraising activities and school events, speak over the PA at Monday Morning Announcements, pack away the table tennis equipment, actively work with the community, build positive team spirit, attitudes and efforts, and welcome visitors to the school.

Student Representative Councillors

Attend the Halogen Foundation National Leader's Day (March), attend regular SRC meetings, host fundraising activities, assist the Head Students, hoist the flags each day, welcome visitors to the school, actively work with the community, set up the table tennis equipment each day, and build positive team spirit, attitudes and efforts.



Faction Captains and Faction Vice Captains

Attend the Halogen Foundation National Leader's Day (March), assist their faction for sporting events, organise sports equipment for morning fitness and Friday sport, recess and lunch time activities, collect the school recycling, count faction cards, lead the cheerleading at carnivals, calculate TRACK points each week, and build positive team spirit, attitudes and efforts.

Students who would like to nominate for a leadership position in 2024 will be required to fill out and submit to Mr Parkinson the 2024 Leadership Nomination Form by Monday, 30th October. All students who have nominated for a leadership position will be required to present in front of the Year 5 students and current Year 6 Student Leaders in the Assembly Area on Wednesday, 8th November. The Student Elections (voting) will be held on Thursday, 9th November from 11am – 1pm in the Library. The leaders for 2024 will be announced on Friday, 8th December at the Senior Book Awards. Parents will be notified on Friday, 1st December if their child has received a leadership position and will be invited to attend the ceremony.

Due to extra responsibilities outside of the classroom, please take into consideration that student leaders are to catch up on any work they have missed in their own time and will need to maintain their academic studies. Late nominations will not be accepted.
