MORNING GREETING

LITERACY ACTIVITIES

We are learning to identify and name farm animals. Open the farm scene that was posted to ClassDojo. Ask your child to point to and name different animals in the picture. Play 'I Spy' with the picture, make the sound of an animal and have your child name the animal that makes that sound.

and / or

Sing 'Old McDonald Had a Farm' and have your child choose the animal on the farm. Encourage them to make the noise of the farm animal and even act it out!

MORNING TEA

NUMERACY ACTIVITIES

We are learning to recognise and draw circles. Support your child to draw circles of different sizes. Large, medium and small (or more of varying sizes if you choose). Children colour and then cut out the circles the best they can and glue them together with the biggest circle on the bottom, and the smallest on the top. An example of this activity is on ClassDojo.

and / or

Send your child on a circle hunt around the house. They can bring the circles they find and put them in a pile or make a circle with them. If you have paper towel rolls or toilet paper rolls you can make binoculars with your child to use on the circle hunt. Ask your child to choose their favourite circle and let them take a photo of it and upload it to their ClassDojo portfolio.

LUNCH

PLAY, LAUGH 'N' CREATE

We are celebrating our wonderful Mum's/Carers and appreciating all that they do for us.

Activity ideas:

Make Mum breakfast in bed (if you have a secret helper to help you stay safe in the kitchen)

Make a necklace for Mum using wool, string, penne pasta, beads, natural materials etc.

Make Mum a card, you can try and draw a love heart and a picture of you and Mum and ask a helper to write a special message about why you love your Mum so much. Have a go at writing your name in your card.
