Day One

Literacy Activity: Tuning into Sounds- Which Instrument?

- This activity uses two identical sets of instruments or noise makers. If you don't
 have instruments at home use common household objects such as saucepan and
 spoon, keys or make some shakers using empty water bottles and rice. Give your
 child the opportunity to play one set to introduce the sounds each instrument
 makes and name them all.
- Then hide behind a screen and choose one instrument from the identical set to play. Encourage your child to identify which instrument has been played.

Pre-handwriting Activity: Zig zag lines going up and down

Zig zags going up and down- using toy cars or trucks practise driving in a zig zag pattern. You can use chalk or masking tape to make a zig zag road to guide your child.



Numeracy Activity: Number 5

Play hide and seek, hiding teddies or toys. Count to 10 before finding them.

Revise the numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Use your finger to trace the Number 5 while reciting 'Short neck, belly fat. Mr Five wears a hat.' Trace the number 5 using multiple coloured crayons.

- -5 insects
- -5 cars

- -Number 5 on letterbox
- -Number 5 on a car number plate
