Faction Captains and Faction Vice Captains

Attend the Halogen Foundation National Leader's Day (March), assist their faction for sporting events, organise sports equipment for morning fitness and Friday sport, recess and lunch time activities, collect the school recycling, count faction cards, lead the cheerleading at carnivals, calculate points each week and build positive team spirit, attitudes and efforts.
