Uniform Policy

(updated 11th April 2019)

The West Byford Primary School uniform plays an important role in promoting student pride, developing self-confidence, a feeling of belonging, and establishing a positive community identity. Acceptance of enrolment at West Byford Primary School assumes an agreement between the parent and the school that the student will dress in accordance with the school's uniform policy. Every student is expected to comply with the uniform policy in the same way that they are expected to comply with all school policies.

Guidelines

Students are to wear the designated uniform during school hours, to and from school, and while attending school excursions. Parents are asked to cooperate by ensuring that students wear their uniform to school every day. It is the expectation that students will be dressed in uniforms that are clean, neat and tidy at all times.

Uniform Requirements

Item	Acceptable
Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• West Byford Primary School shirt with the school logo.• Students may wear plain white short sleeve t-shirts or plain white singlets under their school shirts• School shirts must be worn under school jackets
Dress/Skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• West Byford Primary School skirt or dress with the school logo
Pants/Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• West Byford Primary School pants or shorts with the school logo
Jackets	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• West Byford Primary School jacket with the school logo
Socks & Stockings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plain ankle socks• Plain navy opaque stockings may be worn during cold weather
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Footwear must be closed in and be appropriate for sport.
Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A wide brim, sun safe hat with the school logo.
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One pair of small, plain gold or silver studs or small sleepers may be worn• A small wrist watch may be worn• A small religious symbol on a delicate chain may be worn.

Accessories, Make Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Make up or nail polish is to be worn • No fashion accessories are permitted
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair should be clean, neat and tidy • Hair longer than collar length should be tied back at all times • Only discrete hair accessories in WBPS colours permitted. • Only natural hair colours permitted (endorsed School Board (12/18))

- When a student is out of uniform, they will be asked to report to the Administration Office to obtain a uniform pass. Students who receive more than 5 uniform passes during the term will be ineligible to attend Reward Play - a school activity which is not an essential part of the educational program for students.
- Parents who are unable to provide uniforms for their children because of financial stress or matters beyond their control, such as shortage of supply, will be supported by the school so that students concerned will not be disadvantaged. This may include second hand uniforms, or the school arranging purchase of uniforms. The school will make every effort to cooperate with parents to ensure students are in uniform.
- School uniforms may be purchased at the Uniform Shop located at West Byford Primary School.
