Where to meet: Park at the corner of Ballawarra Avenue and Wundi Way, Byford. (A)

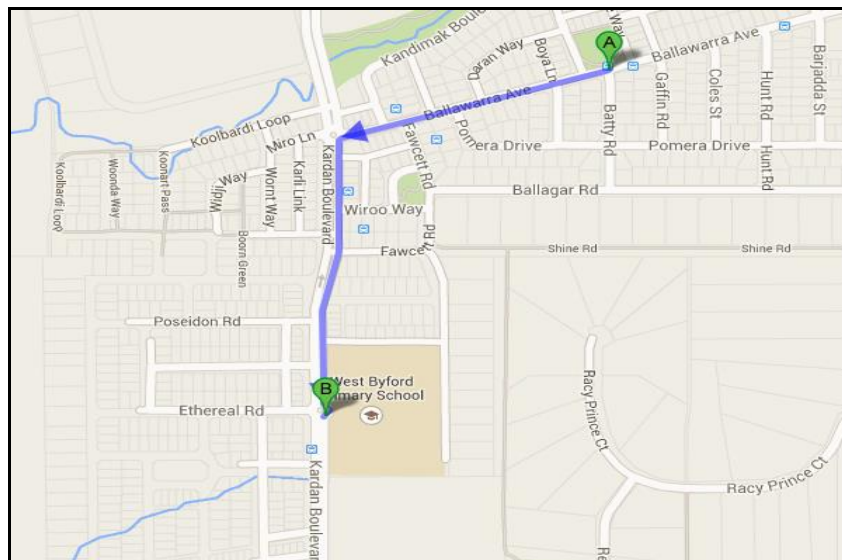
Date: Friday, 12th November 2021
