

Uniform Policy

The West Byford Primary School (WBPS) uniform plays an important role in promoting student pride, developing self-confidence, a feeling of belonging, and establishing a positive community identity. Acceptance of enrolment at WBPS assumes an agreement between the parent and the school that the student will dress in accordance with the school's uniform policy. Every student is expected to comply with the uniform policy in the same way that they are expected to comply with all school policies.

Guidelines

Students are to wear the designated uniform during school hours, to and from school, and while attending school excursions. Parents are asked to cooperate by ensuring that students wear the correct uniform to school every day, adhering to what is acceptable, as listed below. Students are expected to be dressed in uniforms that are clean, neat and tidy, at all times.

Uniform Requirements

Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> WBPS shirt with school logo WBPS shirt must be worn under school jacket Plain white short sleeve t-shirt or plain white singlet under WBPS shirt may be worn
Dress/Skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> WBPS skirt or dress with school logo
Pants/Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> WBPS pants or shorts with school logo
Jackets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> WBPS jacket with school logo
Socks & Stockings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plain white or navy ankle socks Plain navy opaque stockings, tights or leggings may be worn under other uniform items.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closed-in and appropriate for sport, i.e. joggers not boots
Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> West Byford Primary School Reversible Sun-Safe Bucket Hat with school logo
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One pair of small, plain gold or silver studs or small sleepers may be worn Small watch may be worn Small religious symbol on a delicate chain may be worn
Accessories & Make-Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No make-up or nail polish to be worn No fashion accessories to be worn
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hair should be clean, neat and tidy Hair longer than collar length must be tied back Discrete hair accessories in WBPS colours permitted i.e. no large bows or coloured hair extensions Natural hair colours, only permitted

- Parents who are unable to provide uniforms for their children due to financial stress or matters beyond their control, such as shortage of supply, will be supported by the school so that students concerned will not be disadvantaged; this may include second-hand uniforms. The school will make every effort to cooperate with parents to ensure students are in uniform.

- School uniforms, including hat, to be worn during all outdoor activities including recess, lunch, Physical Education, sport and excursions.
- Hats must be clearly labelled with the student's name. Non-school hats are not permitted.
- Students who do not have their school hat will be required to remain in designated shaded areas in line with the school's SunSmart procedures.
- A student may temporarily lose Good Standing if they have five uniform infringements within a term. Loss of Good Standing serves to support students in meeting school expectations while promoting personal responsibility and positive behaviour.
